# ***How do you think we can support the Welbourne community?***

- Support homework/home learning. Support parents' as they do not know what they are doing in that week or day. Channel between teachers and the rest of the parents.
- Once a month parents meeting - coffee morning, discuss home learning, support. Community meeting, differing topics each month depending on discussions via whats app groups.
- Forum to hear from each other about their Welbourne experiences. Groups discussions useful.
- Events, bring community together to make events even better for the children. E.g. Easter egg hunt - make experiences memorable for the children. Working together to support the cultures in our community. Community groups support events in the school to develop understanding of our diversity. Develop pride in our identity.
- Engagement with the wider community, including the elderly. Making links between generations - residential home on Chestnut Road.
- School disco (event). Celebrate leavers, Christmas - small charge for tickets for fundraising.
- Fundraising opportunities for the school. Identify other funding streams that we could be eligible for.
- After school clubs, pricing could be a barrier to afford it. Could parents' time be volunteered for an after school club that is free?
- Bake sales, be specific what the fundraising is for. E.g. wider range books for the library. Not just 'For the school'. Develop an opportunity to talk to other parents.
- Children goals in life? Career support - meet professionals so that children have aspirations and goals. Skills audit of our parent community could help.
