<p>1. Funds raised by FoW. What will FOW money raised be spent on?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lots of interest for books, so could we fund some series for the library (Diary of a Wimpy kid, Dog Man and Captain Underpants) so could we fund some more of these books for the classes? • Playground equipment. • Additional learning resources for children who are struggling to keep up with learning. • Funding/ supporting translation and community to support more vulnerable parents - speak to June, to see what she might be need. Could we fund some coffee mornings for new to the school or to strengthen community? • Extra-curricular activities, school visitors and trips actors. • Summer term trip – Walton on the Naze (or similar seaside trip). Whole school trips. We would like PTA funding to support trips and extra curricular activities that school finances would otherwise not allow. • Year 6 leavers – graduation with a celebration. 	<p>Actions</p> <p>Confirm with Mr Lane which of these seem the most appropriate.</p> <p>Confirm whether we are able to support the Y6 graduation somehow.</p>
<p>2. Planning Discos</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proposed time 4:15 – 5:30 (allowing for clear up time and for students who attend after school club to attend the disco and be back for pick up). • £2:00 per ticket. Price of the ticket would include a drink, pack of crisps and a glow stick. • Tickets to be printed by FoW, and sold by class teachers/ school office. • Tickets exchanged for two raffle tickets on entry – pink for drink and a blue one for snack. • Enter through the gate on the High Cross Road. Parents to be stationed around the gate/ hall. Clear NO entry signs for children/ parents. Clear expectations around where they are allowed to go. • Only toilets by hall to be used and to be monitored by FoW. • DJ – sound system, ensuring appropriate lyrics • Potential tuck shop for the 5/6 disco? • Suggested dates: late June/Early July. • Grouped by age. (Rec, Y1, Y2) – (Y3, Y4) – (Y5, Y6) • What would be the best day of the week? Would three consecutive Fridays work, or would three consecutive days in one week be better? 	<p>Confirm dates and plan for disco with Mr Lane as per school calendar.</p>
<p>3. Role of FoW at Summer Fair</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Friday 7th July. 	<p>Nana Explore options around bouncy castles.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Colour day in the day so that we generate a buzz around the day. Could the FOW take pictures during assembly etc at this time? Could we create a Welbourne rainbow (as per our school logo!) by grouping the children by the colour of their clothes! Children are asked to wear one block colour for the day. • Suggested stalls to be run by FOW: Bric-a-brac stall, Tombola, Sponge the teacher, Cake sale, adult book swap, decorate your own biscuit, Craft stall (making items) • 3 x Bouncy castle (with a charge of £200) might be available. FoW could 'police' this. Nana has a contact and will explore. • Confirm with Ingy if businesses are to be invited in to sell goods and what is this process for this. 	<p>Confirm with Ingy if businesses are to be invited in to sell goods and what is this process for this.</p>
<p>4. Roles and responsibilities within the FoW</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move to Year group Reps rather than class reps. 	<p>Revisit the class reps list to ensure representation across the school.</p>
<p>5. AoB</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ese suggested a whole class competition such as baking week. Maybe the funds raised by the FoW could provide resources, and FoW could volunteer their time to work with classes ? 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annie suggested we explore links to additional charities etc, to access additional funding for the school, such as Fair share. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nonie spoke about GeoDevelop – General Projects, Florentia, • They would like to invite some students into their facilities to work within the space and would like to host some workshops that may fit nicely with Y6 careers development etc. (Bikes, bridal, fine arts florist, lighting maker) • N4 – so local. • May be useful to the curriculum? • Could we suggest a Y6 trip day (after SATS) when they come and meet the workshops? 	<p>Can we link Nonia up with Y6 teachers to see what we can plan?</p>
