## Activities to Support your Child's Learning Topic: Colour a Rainbow

Pictures by Eric Carle Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You Seer by Bill Martin, Jr	Watch and listen to the story "Brown Bear, Brown Bear" Ask your child what animals they can remember from the story and which one is their favourite animal. Encourage your child to draw that animal and share your pictures with your teachers on Tapestry. <u>https://youtu.be/E7tvOttlitA?si=tDlQyf0VoC-PLonh</u>
	Draw or paint a rainbow and get your child to name the colours they can see.

	<ul> <li>Make your favourite colour playdough using the recipe below,</li> <li>Playdough Recipe -You will need</li> <li>8 tbsp plain flour, 2 tbsp table salt, 60ml warm water, food colouring, 1 tbsp vegetable oil</li> <li>Method</li> <li>1. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. In a separate bowl mix together the water, a few drops of food colouring and the oil.</li> <li>2. Pour the coloured water into the flour mix and bring together with a spoon.</li> <li>3. Dust a work surface with a little flour and turn out the dough. Knead together for a few minutes to form a smooth, pliable dough. If you want a more intense colour you can work in a few extra drops of food colouring.</li> <li>4. Store in a plastic sandwich bag (squeeze out the air) in the fridge to keep it fresh.</li> <li>Try to make some of the animals from the story Brown Bear.</li> </ul>
