<p>Choose a book and tell your adult what was your favourite part of the story.</p> 	<p>Look around your home or local environment. What shapes can you see? Can you name them?</p> 	<p>Tell your child a story from your childhood (folktale).</p> 
<p>It is getting dark. What animals come out at night time? Draw a picture and write about it.</p> 	<p>Can you talk about the sequence of your day? Draw a picture of the things that you did. Breakfast in the morning, playing with family members, dinner and then bedtime.</p> 	<p>Can you discuss healthy food choices and model how to use cutlery? Can children practise independently dressing?</p>

What was your favourite kind of weather?</p> 	<p>Play a game and place your favourite toy around your home using the positional language on, beside, under next to and behind.</p> 	<p>Cook your favourite meal with your adults. You could make a toasty cheese sandwich.</p>
