


Reception Autumn 2 Home Learning

| Can you go on a journey and write about it? For example, I went on the bus to the park. I walked to the shops. | On your journey to and from school talk about the numbers you can see on buses and car number plates? Can you count the amount of buses you see? | Can you use different resources to make a different mode of transport and share it with the class on Tapestry? |
| Can you go over all the sounds that we have learnt so far? Can you do the actions to help you remember? | How many different types of transport have you been in or seen over the week? | Collect some natural things such as leaves, conkers, twigs and make a picture with them. |
| Choose a book and tell your adult what was your favourite part of the story. | Look around your home or local environment. What shapes can you see? Can you name them? | Tell your child a story from your childhood (folktale). |
| It is getting dark. What animals come out at night time? Draw a picture and write about it. | Can you talk about the sequence of your day? Draw a picture of the things that you did. Breakfast in the morning, playing with family members, dinner and then bedtime. | Can you discuss healthy food choices and model how to use cutlery? Can children practise independently dressing? |
| Draw a picture of what the weather has been like. What was your favourite kind of weather? | Play a game and place your favourite toy around your home using the positional language on, beside, under next to and behind. | Cook your favourite meal with your adults. You could make a toasty cheese sandwich. |
