Talk to them about what you have read.</li> </ul></li></ul>		<ul> <li>Money</li> <li>Children will learn to: <ul> <li>Recognise coins, notes and amounts of money</li> <li>Make the same amount using different coins</li> <li>Count notes and coins to find totals</li> <li>Add amounts, and take away to find change.</li> <li>Problem solving involving money.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Multiplication and Division <ul> <li>Multiplication facts for the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables</li> <li>Mental and written methods for multiplication and division.</li> </ul> </li> <li>How to help at home: Practice finding different amounts with coins.
