

Nursery Spring 2 Home Learning Activities to Support your Child's Learning <u>Topics:</u>

- Magical and Fantasy Figures (e.g. dragons, monsters, unicorn)
- Dinosaurs

The FOGGY FOGGY FOREST FOREST Kick Sharratt	Watch and listen to the story "The Foggy, Foggy Forest" <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8E2PrOAxTKg</u> Discuss with your child what is their favourite part of the story. Encourage your child to describe what they saw in the Foggy, Foggy Forest. Talk about the characters in the story.
Room on the Broom	Watch and listen to the story "The Room on the Broom" <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PHxGe44wSCI</u> Discuss with your child what is their favourite part of the story.
	Make your own unicorn or dinosaur using recycled materials or your toy blocks, duplo or lego. Discuss the different body parts of a unicorn for example a tail, 4 legs, a horn, etc. Give your unicorn a name and share your creation with your family and Nursery on Tapestry.

	Practise finger numbers up to 5 and then up to 10 <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mKUbgOG00As</u> Practise this frequently with your children. Hold up different amounts of fingers and get them to say how many they can see.
SD Geometric Shapes rectangular prism cylinder Cub Cub Cub Cub Cub Cub Cub Cub	Explore 2D and 3D shapes and talk about these shapes using informal and mathematical language: 'sides', 'corners', 'straight', 'round'. Join your child and play freely with blocks, shapes, shape puzzles and discuss questions like "What is the same and what is different?". Talk about shapes as you play with them: "We need a piece with a straight edge".
