## English

# Mathematics

## Core English text: Look up!

- A range of writing activities including writing a letter in role
- Continue to use full stops and capital letters
- Use 'and' to join simple sentences
- Begin to use a range of interesting verbs and adjectives.

### Non Fiction: One Day on our Blue Planet....in the Savanna

- Use talk to give explanations and opinions
- Write for meaning and purpose for a non-fiction leaflet
- Explore where information can be found in non-fiction texts and that it can be retrieved from a variety of sources

#### **Phonics**

- Extend our phonics knowledge by focusing on split digraphs, a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e, and u-e
- Practice our Phase 5 sounds using Welbourne videos.
- Some sounds include: ay, ou, ie, oy, ir, ue, aw, wh, ph, ew, oe,

How to help at home: Go through the phonics videos on Google Classroom. Practice writing and reading tricky words. Encourage children to use talk to justify reasons and opinions.

- Addition and Subtraction (within 50)
  - Addition and subtraction to 50 using a range of techniques
    - Concrete (using counters)
    - Pictorial (drawing dots to represent a number)
    - Using a number line to help with their jumps.

### Length & Height

- Understand that height is a type of length
- Compare lengths and heights of objects using language such as "longer than", "shorter than" and "taller than".

#### Mass & Volume

- Exploring the terms 'heavier and lighter' and 'empty and full'
- Measuring and comparing mass
- Measuring and comparing capacity.

How to help at home: Practice counting on and back within 50. Compare lengths and heights using phrases like 'shorter/longer/taller than. Compare the mass of objects using 'heavier and lighter' and 'Empty and full'



## Science

## History

#### Intriguing Animals

- Identify animals in our local area
- Classify animals based on their diets, and animal types
- Describe different animals
- Explore animals from different continents

How to help at home: Talk about animals that you may see while you are out and about. Can you describe them? Do they have beaks, wings, feathers, fur? Talk to your child about different mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish, birds and insects.

## The First Flight

- Looking at the history of Flight
- Amelia Earhart and Bessie Colman.
- Recall and sequence facts
- Explore how flight has changed over time.

### How to help at home:

# Religious Education

This term we will focus on 'Healthy Me'.

- Explain and understand how to be healthy
- Explain how to make healthy choices
- Understand hygiene and health
- Learn how to keep themselves and others safe.

How to help at home: Discuss healthy food choices and hygiene. Discuss how to stay safe around medicines and roads.

This term we will learn: What do Christian's believe God is like?

- Parables stories told by Jesus to teach his followers about
- How many Christians put their beliefs into practice through worship.

How to help at home: Discuss the beliefs of the Christian faith and make comparisons with other faiths.

# Physical Education

We will be learning a topic called 'Grouping Data' which will provide children with an introduction to data and information. Children will learn about:

- Collecting data
- Sorting objects into different groups
- Using their ability to sort objects into different groups to answer questions about data

How to help at home: Practise counting different objects and grouping them e.g. How many red cars did we see?



# Dance:

- Learning a range of physical skills such as travel, copying, and performing actions, using shape, balance and coordination
- Create their own dance routines
- Copy, repeat, create and perform actions that represent the theme.
