	Practise saying and writing the following sounds: s, a, t, p, i, n . Please look at the website at the bottom for support.		Discuss and sort objects based on their colour, size or what type of object they are.		Look out of the window. What is the weather like? Draw or paint a picture of the weather.
	Can you draw a picture of what you like doing in reception and label it?		Can you sing a number-song or nursery rhyme and use your fingers or small props to help count the items, e.g. 5 Little Ducks		Get your adults to teach you a dance or a song from their country. Upload on to Tapestry and share with us.
	Get your adult to read you their favourite story. Tell your adult: What you liked about the story? What you didn't like?		Use objects around the house to create different types of repeating patterns.		What is your favourite food? Draw or paint a picture of it.
	We will be reading the story 'Owl Babies'. Can you find out three facts about owls?		Make handprints of everyone's hands in your family. Put them in order of size from the smallest to the largest handprint?		Help your adults to tidy up your home. You can sweep, dust or help them to wash up the dishes.
