- **Enhance Problem-Solving:** Children evaluate complex situations and adapt their strategies.

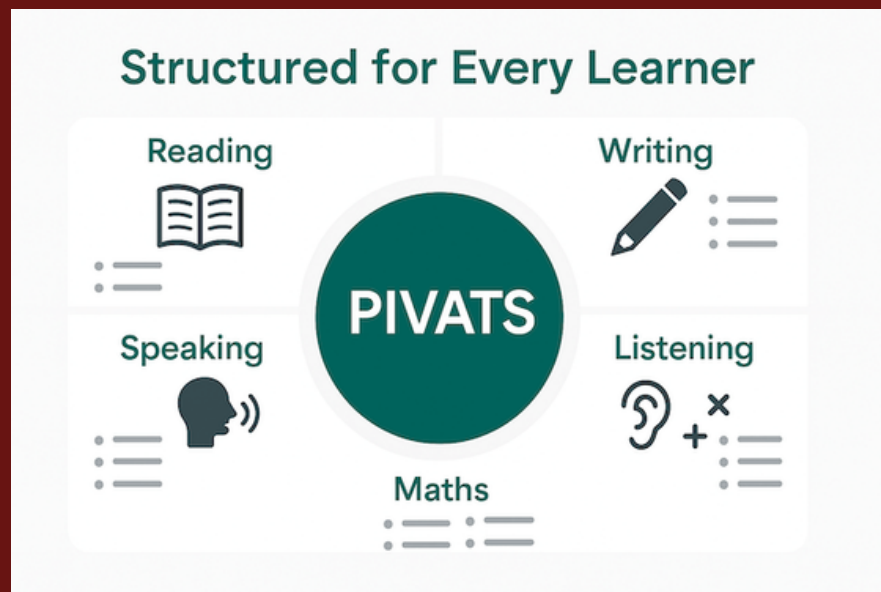




How we assess SEND: Using PIVATS, teachers set realistic targets, monitor progress in fine detail, and adapt teaching so every learner moves forward with confidence.

We are working closely with Haringey Education Partnership to move to using PIVATS where it will help SEND pupils in Y1-Y6.



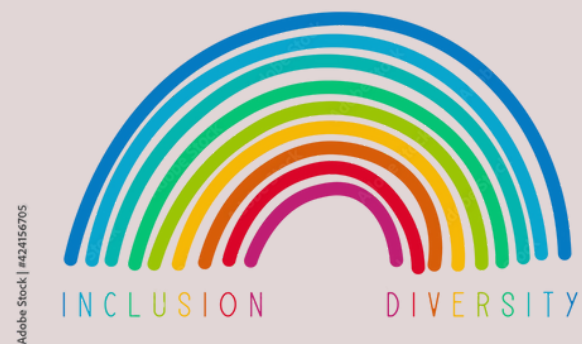

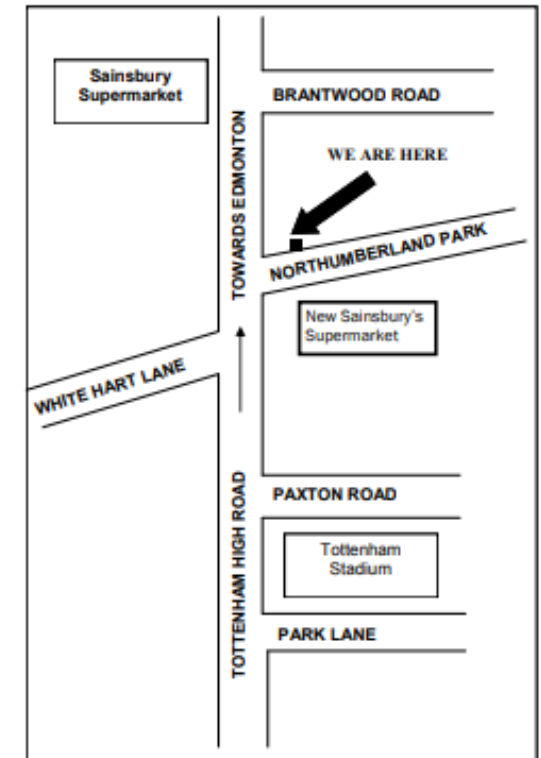

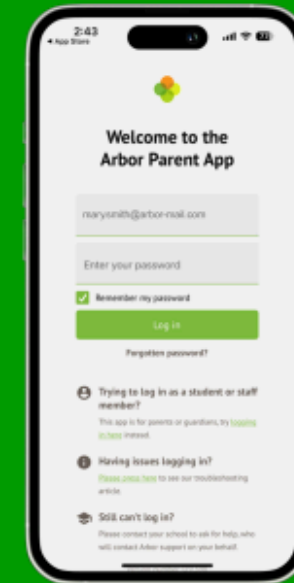
